Dear Parents,

We welcome you to Wasatch Presbyterian Preschool (WPP) for the coming school year and look forward to continuing with and expanding our tradition of providing quality preschool experiences for all children. We hope your summer goes well as you anticipate your child's attendance at school this fall.

Enclosed is a copy of a 2010-2011 school calendar and some thoughts on Separation Anxiety, a common issue at the beginning of each school year. Here are some important dates to remember.

- **Wednesday, August 25th:** Posting of Class Lists: Class lists are posted on the front door of the school. Come check out who is in your child's class and what teachers your child has.
- **Thursday, August 26th: Parent Orientation, 7:00 p.m. (for parents only).** Parents gather in the Sanctuary of the church for a general meeting with the Director. When this short meeting is over parents meet with teachers and have an opportunity to ask questions. You can also complete Registration Packets and leave them with us at this time or take them home and return them to us at "Open House."
- **Monday and Tuesday, August 30 and 31st: Open House/Registration Day.** During Open House, parents accompany children to school to meet teachers and get used to new classrooms. Registration packets are completed and turned in. **Be sure to bring your child's immunization information with you so you can fill out the immunization form.**
- **Wednesday and Friday, September 1st and 3rd: First day to drop children off at class.** Parents drop children off at the class door and leave them for the whole class time.

At WPP, the learning of pre-Kindergarten skills, high self-esteem, social skills and trust in others, take place in a safe, nurturing environment, free from fear of failure. We commit to offering a program where all children, from all backgrounds, learn and feel welcome.

As always, contact our office with any questions or concerns that you might have. During the summer we check for messages once a week until the middle of August when we will do so more often.
