Registration for the coming school year is about to begin!

The deadline for returning students is February 1, 2010. All children or siblings of children already attending Wasatch that want to return, need to apply by this date. These students have first choice of available classes.

The deadline for new students is March 1, 2010. New student forms need to be turned in by this date.

We place students into available spaces in random order. Applications are accepted until all openings are taken. Waiting lists begin after the program is full.
