FALL IS HERE

ADJUSTMENT IN REGISTRATION FEES

The Preschool Advisory Board voted to change registration fees beginning January of 2010, when registration for the 2010-2011 school year begins. We provide you with this information early so that parents can plan ahead and set

aside the extra money needed to register.

The \$100 registration fee is still nonrefundable and due when students are admitted to our program. At the same time we will also require the "last month's tuition." It also is not refundable for families that choose to leave our program early but will be used for tuition during May for those families who stay for the total year.

We hope this adjustment will encourage families to commit to our program as they register, deterring last minute changes from school to school. In the past, these late changes in enrollment made it difficult for our preschool to efficiently organize and pre-

pare for the beginning of school. They also make it impossible to provide important scheduling information to teachers and families before school begins.

We are all concerned about the safety of children in our schools. We have a plan in place if a dangerous incident were to happen here at our school. We keep the buzzer door

at the entrance to the hallway, locked between drop-off and pick-up time each day. Also, the door at the other end of the hall is locked making it so that only people with keys can enter from that end of the school. Teachers keep their outside doors locked except when in use. We

also have several ways to exit the building if we need to and we provide emergency kits for the children should we need to stay here. I feel confident that we could handle most any situation adequately.
