EMERGENCY KITS

Turn in money for your Emergency Kits as soon as possible. It is a requirement at our school that all

children attending have one. If you would like to make your own, check with the office first to see what needs to be in it and what size it should be. Those who do neither will be billed automatically for the one that our school makes for the children. The kits will arrive and be distributed in October.

TUITION

Tuition is due the first day of every month. After the 10th of each month there will be a \$5/day late fee.

Pay tuition by the month or pay for the whole year all at once. Make checks payable to WPP. Tuition this year is \$178/mo., and two-day tuition is \$127/mo.

PARENT REMINDER

We remind you to bring

Do not worry about sending drinks. We will serve ice water. Do not send sweet treats unless it is your child's birthday!

SHOES

Remember to send your children to school wearing shoes with closed toes and heels. Flip flops and sandals cause accidents on the playground.

PLAYGROUND

If you need to enter the playground to play with your child, enter through the school, not through the playground gate. We do not want children escaping through an unlocked gate. Always enter the school through the front door, not

A NOTE FROM THE DIRECTOR

You can make all the difference in your child's ability to separate from you at the beginning of class. Positive comments, reassurances, hugs and kisses at the door help your

children feel competent and confident. Long good-byes prolong anxious feelings they have while entering the classroom. When you leave quickly it allows us to get right into our familiar routine. However, if you think your child will adjust better to school if you stay for a session or two at the

beginning of the year, please feel free to discuss this option with the teacher.

After the first two weeks, we respectfully ask that you do not stay in the classroom once class has begun. It is all right to leave an unhappy Child. Crying usually lasts only a few minutes. We will

call you if it continues for too long. Eventually, most children do not cry at all. We ask that you give teachers the chance to bond with your child, without parents for a few weeks. After that you are welcome to visit! Just let your teacher know.
