CHILD SAFETY

Occasionally, some parents leave infants and toddlers unaccompanied in cars while bringing older children into preschool. This is a friendly reminder that this practice is not safe as well as against the law.

Think how badly we would all feel if something bad happened to one of these children while left unattended in a car. Take the time to bring younger children in with you as you drop off older children for class.

Also remember that small children should be restrained in the back seat of a car. Air bags would kill a young child sitting in the front seat if you were ever in an accident.

A Note From the Director

Each year I have some parents inquire about how we protect personal information at our school. The following is our policy regarding such information.

Confidentiality Policy

WPP keeps all personal information about students confidential. We receive written permission before personal information is given to other pertinent agencies, schools, programs or people. Personal information is kept locked in file cabinets in the preschool office. Informal testing results are kept in portfolios in the classrooms. The Salt Lake City School District does formal testing and results are given only to parents. Teachers put screening or testing results in the classroom in individual portfolios for the children. They are referred to when designing activities and curriculum. This helps individualize the curriculum to the levels and needs of the children. Portfolio's of children's work are sent home with parents at the end of each school year. Records are then stored for several years and then destroyed.

The following individuals have access to these files during the school year: Health department, Special Needs Consultants, Teachers and Office staff,, Parents, Teachers, and Courts if asked for in divorce proceedings.
