WELCOME!

Welcome to preschool! We hope the first week of school goes well. We look forward to a great start and a wonderful year.

ATTENTION PARENTS!

Many parents think that the tuition paid at registration time applies to the first month of school instead of the last month. The purpose for paying the last month's tuition up front is so that if a child needs to drop from our program early in the year, their last month's tuition can serve as a cushion for us financially while we find someone to take that child's place. When May rolls around at the end of the year, if you are still here your tuition will al-

ready be paid for.

In the mean time, September's tuition is due by September 10th, 2011.

EMERGENCY KITS

Turn in money for your Emergency Kits as soon as possible. Every child attending Wasatch is required to have one. If you would like to make your own, check with the office first to see what needs to be in it and what size it should be. Then, bring it into the office so we can approve it's contents.

Those who do neither are billed automatically for the one that our school makes. The kits arrive and be distributed in October.

TUITION

Tuition is due the first class day of every month.

After the 10th of each month there is a \$5/day late fee.

Pay tuition by the month or pay for the whole year all at once. Make checks payable to WPP. Three day tuition this year is \$180/mo., and two-day tuition is \$130/mo.

PARENT REMINDER

We remind you to bring snack on your assigned day.

Do not worry about sending drinks. We will serve ice water. Do not send sweet treats unless it is your child's birthday!

SHOES

Remember to send your children to school wearing shoes with closed toes and heels. Flip flops and sandals cause accidents on the playground.

A NOTE FROM THE DIRECTOR

You can make all the difference in your child's ability to separate from you at the beginning of class. Positive comments, reassurances, hugs and kisses at the door help your

children feel competent and confident. Long good-byes prolong anxious feelings they have while entering the classroom. When you leave quickly it allows us to get right into our familiar routine. However, if you think your child will adjust better to school if you stay for a session or two at the

beginning of the year, please feel free to discuss this option with the teacher.

After the first two weeks, we respectfully ask that you do not stay in the classroom once class has begun. It is all right to leave an unhappy Child. Crying usually lasts only a few minutes. We will

call you if it continues for too long. Eventually, most children do not cry at all. We ask that you give teachers the chance to bond with your child, without parents for a few weeks. After that you are welcome to visit! Just let your teacher know.
